The Friends are always looking for new exhibits for our annual celebration. Do you have something to share? Our visitors would love to see your historic hobbies and machinery exhibited.

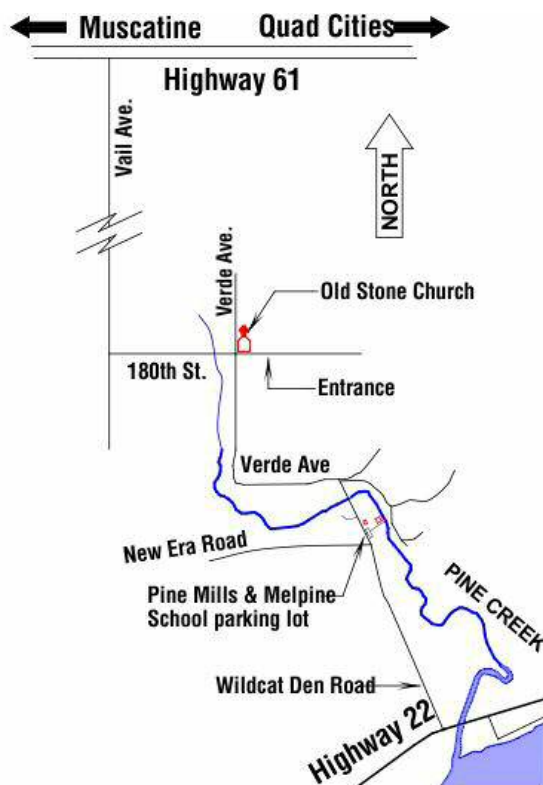
Help Friends of Pine Creek Grist Mill accomplish its mission:
